Praying for our International Workers



Victor and Betty responded to God's call to full-time mission work in 2009. On a vision trip to Mexico City, the Chins were watching thousands of people passing through the Metro stations when God impressed upon their hearts that these people are like lost sheep without a shepherd. They prayed and asked the Lord how they could bring the truth to the people of Mexico City.

The Metro Church project is a way to reach out to the five million people who use the Metro subway system every day. In 2012, Victor and Betty were commissioned as international workers to Mexico to fulfill the vision of planting churches in the proximity of various metro stations.

Mexico City is home to more than twenty-five million people, making it one of the largest cities in the world. It is also the capital city of Mexico and attracts migrant workers from all over the country, so most indigenous cultures can be found there.

The Chins are currently working with a couple from a local church who are called to plant a church in the city. They walk alongside this couple to minister and build relationships within the community.
