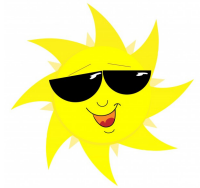

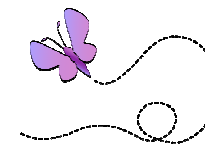

AAC Youth Summer at the Park

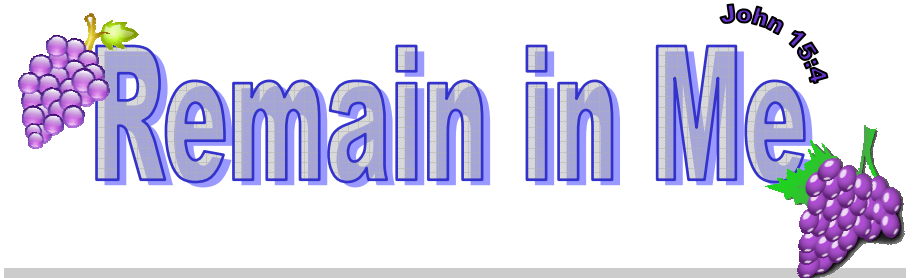
